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ASSESMANT OF COGNITIVE ABILÎTES AT PERSONES SITUATED IN OLD PEOPLE HOME IN BITOLA

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Abstract

Objectives: Assessment of cognitive demage in persons institucionaly situated in old people home in Bitola and the reasons for cognitive defficit.

Materials and methods: The is a cross sectional study in which 84 examines are included, who are permanently situated in the Home. As an instrument for the study is used MiniMental State Examination (MMSE). MMSE is among the most widely researched instruments for screening cognitive impairment. This global assessment tool measures orientation to time and place, word recall, language abilities, attention and calculation, and visuospatial skills. Any score greater than or equal to 24 points (out of 30) indicates a normal cognition. Below this, scores can indicate cognitive impairment.

Resultats: Out of total number of examines (84), at 24 (12%) is confirmed a scor 24, 47 examines (56%), have a scor bellow 24, and at 27 examines (32%) is noticed scor above 24. Statistical significant is registries between age and score bellow 24.

Conclusion: The study indicates that 56% have impairment of cognitive capacities, as a result caused by organic disorders of central nervous system that indicates demention.
