	Aim of the study is to evaluate attitudes towards violence in famillies that live in rural area in the provinity of Pitels. In the study many included for its
	rural area in the proximity of Bitola. In the study were included famillies with children aged 0-6 years who live in 11 villages with less than 1000 inhabitants.
	<b>Methodology:</b> We gathered information from 113 households; A structured
	questionnaire was designed for purpose of the study. The data was given by the
	children's' parents.
	Results: 336 adults were included, 172 women and 164 men. Average age of
	respondents was 40 years and most prominent positions related to violence was in
	that age group. Generaly, 127 adults (38%) expressed views that support different
	forms of violence between partners in the family. Neglect of a child is presented as
	the most common cause of manifestation of violence in the family.(52%) The
	distribution of violent events in famlly by gender is equal. Low level of education is
	related to expressed psychological pressure on partner. (<0.002)
	Discussion: In families in rural areas, violent attitudes among partners are
	represented mostly in the age group of 40 years, with equal distribution between
	genders. Low level of eduction is risk factor for familly violence
	Conclusion: Regardless of the conditions of life in rural areas, there are no
	differences in the manifestation of family violence by sex; coercion is recognized
	as violence, which speaks of a certain emancipation of women in the family.
